February was a busy month at the school. The top floor was focussed on the Heritage Fair. This was an excellent learning experience for teachers and students. Project based learning was a shift in genre reading non fiction, making and organizing notes and then presentation prep. We will make some changes for next year and with the first year behind us, the students will have a better understanding of the big picture.

We received the Cheque from Paul Russell for the sign. It was a busy month for the graphic artist, but he just sent us the latest version. Thoughts on lettering?

We conducted our 2nd lockdown drill with an RCMP officer here to assist. Everything went well.

This term we had Jackie Sanford, a math coach in the school. She worked with 3 teachers on computational fluency. During her last week, she hosted a staff meeting on math running records and the staff is currently using this technique to gather data on their students. It will be our second input on our data wall and is a much more accurate and specific way to look at our learners in math.

We also conducted a well being survey throughout the entire school. Lindsey, our CYCP went around to all classes to work through a Wellness survey with students. It was one area from the SSP survey that we wanted to look deeper into. The questions were:

- I feel safe coming to school
- I feel safe in my classroom
- I have one or more friends at school
- I feel safe playing outside
- I feel safe asking for help

This month we will look at the results and problem solve ways to improve the feeling of safety within the school.

We have a new Schools Plus COW worker: Lisa MacDonald. She is working closely with 3-6 families, helping them with community support.

Caring Schools theme was empathy, and we are moving to Perseverance for March.
