Math Pilot is in full swing for the grade 3 teachers. It has been challenging for the teachers. The 22-23 Math Data supports the need for shifts in our practice and ensuring the vigor in instruction and math learning. Our school is performing very low on the provincial math assessment. Tina is here to support us with the grade 3 pilot but also with shifts throughout the entire school. In December we looked at data as a whole school and areas for improvement. We missed the Dec PD day and will be stretching this PD over the next few staff meetings.

We are deep in planning and practicing for the Family Literacy afternoon and performances. Eleanor is working with teachers on performances, art installations and the script for the day.
